Abdelouahab Zaatri has been graduated as an engineer on electrical engineering from the Polytechnic University of Leuven in Louvain-la-Neuve, Belgium in 1981. He worked at "Sonelgaz", which is a national company of electrical energy while providing lectures in parallel at the University of Constantine (1984-1988). Then, he worked at the University of Constantine since 1993 as an assistant. From 1995-2000, he joined the laboratory of Mechanics at the University of Leuven, in Belgium from which he received the PHD degree on robotics. He returned to the University of Constantine in 2000 and is currently Professor at Mechanical Engineering department. Since then he has launched an educational laboratory called LATA (Laboratory for Advanced Technology Applications).
